Bonbeach	Bonbeach Foreshore Reserve is a coastal strip featuring a wide sandy 1.5 km beach, featuring iconic bathing boxes, and natural habitat which connects to Chelsea Beach to the north and Patterson River to the south. Bonbeach is a wheelchair friendly beach with accessible toilets, shower, paths, ticketed parking and an off-leash dog area . The beach is patrolled by the Bonbeach Surf Life Saving Club.
Queen Victoria Market	Queen St, Melbourne VIC 3000 The Queen Victoria Market is a major landmark in the central business district of Melbourne, Victoria, Australia. Covering over seven hectares, it is the largest open air market in the Southern Hemisphere.
Patterson Lakes	With the best hiking trails, Patterson Lakes has 4 scenic trails in the area. Explore one of 3 easy hiking trails or check out some trails with historic sites. Adventure through the nature areas surrounding Patterson Lakes that are perfect for hikers and outdoor enthusiasts at any skill level.
Chelsea Beach	Chelsea beach consists of a straight and uninterrupted stretch of coastline, providing scenic views southwards to the Mornington Peninsula. A no boating zone is declared at a 300-metre length of coastline around local surf lifesaving club, making this area ideal for safe swimming in the sheltered bay waters. A little further south is a short pier which extends into the sea. The foreshore along the beach consists of low sand dunes with groups of colourful bathing boxes situated in native coastal grasses overlooking the water.

Jells Park Picnic	Jells Park is part of an Aboriginal cultural landscape that includes the traditional Country of the Wurundjeri People. The park covers around 127 hectares (310 acres) and contains 9 km (5.6 mi) of paths for cycling and walking. With many picnic areas and free electric barbecues, find a place to relax under the shade of the Pines, enjoy the lake views at the Elms, abundant birdlife, and lush wetlands and large playground.

The bushland has over 450 indigenous plant species and includes over 10km of walking tracks, six kilometres of cycling tracks, a lookout tower, picturesque shelters, barbecues and playgrounds.
