Souvlaki GR Cranbourne	Souvlaki GR was founded by Sam Karagiozis with the support of his late father Anastasios in early 2016. The Karagiozis family's goal was to combine local Australian produce with traditional Greek street cuisine. Today, Souvlaki GR continues to pay homage to its beginnings by providing the best quality gyros on charcoal in Australia and focusing on supporting local producers and businesses.

Berwick Spring Lake	Berwick Springs is wedged between Greaves Road, Berwick Springs Promenade, The Esplanade and Moondarra Drive in Narre Warren South. A beautiful, maintained lake with walking, bike riding tracks and outdoor playground for all ages. Look out for the Rainbow Trout.
Arthurs Seat Summit Station	795 Arthurs Seat Rd, Arthurs Seat, Victoria 3936 As the highest viewpoint on the Mornington Peninsula, the summit lookout provides magnificent views of Port Phillip Bay. BBQ area.
Dromana Beach	Dromana is a safe swimming beach with life savers patrolling the beach over summer weekends. Colourful bathing boxes line the beach with a playground near the pier for family fun and several BBQ's and gazebos dot the foreshore area making it a lovely picnic area. Several restaurants and coffee shops are conveniently located across the road from the pier area.

Fountain Gate	Westfield Fountain Gate is a super-regional shopping centre located in Narre Warren in the south-eastern suburbs of Melbourne, Australia. It is the second largest shopping centre in Australia by floor area.
Chelsea Beach	Chelsea beach consists of a straight and uninterrupted stretch of coastline, providing scenic views southwards to the Mornington Peninsula. A no boating zone is declared at a 300-metre length of coastline around local surf lifesaving club, making this area ideal for safe swimming in the sheltered bay waters. A little further south is a short pier which extends into the sea. The foreshore along the beach consists of low sand dunes with groups of colourful bathing boxes situated in native coastal grasses overlooking the water.
