It is a popular destination for boating, fishing, picnicking, and views of the inlet and the Western Port Bay.</p> <p>The reserve has a jetty, a shelter, a seawall, toilets, showers, drinking water, and a playground. It also has some early fisherman’s cottages that date back to the 1930s and 1940s.</p> <p>FREE</p>

It was founded by Glen Bell, and he opened the first Taco Bell restaurant back in 1962 in Downey, California.</p> <p>Before Taco Bell, he originally owned and operated a hamburger stand called Bell’s Hamburgers in California, built in 1948 on the border of San Bernardino</p>

	and the city of Colton. Glen opened his first taco stand, Taco Tia in 1954, selling tacos for nineteen cents (AUD\$2.17 value today).
